# Cathay Camps — Terms & Conditions

2026 Mandarin & Culture Immersion Summer Camp

## Code of Student Conduct

Students who intend to participate in Cathay Camps programs must agree to comply with the following Code of Conduct in order to be enrolled.

1. Students must attend every class and complete homework on time.
2. Students must respect teachers, follow instructions from authorized persons, take care of their study materials, keep classrooms clean after use and take responsibility for their own behavior.
3. Students must respect their peers and other people involved in the program, and not harass, threaten, intimidate, harm or insult anyone.
4. Students must not be involved in any fights or commit any violent or illegal acts under Chinese law or the law of their home country.
5. Students must look after their own personal property and must not cause any damage to school property or property belonging to anyone else.
6. Students must be honest, must not lie or steal, and must use polite language and gestures at all times.
7. Individual students under 18 years of age are NOT allowed to leave the campus by themselves.
8. Parents/visitors must ALWAYS SIGN the leave-for-absent sheet before taking students off campus.
9. No smoking, drinking alcohol, or use of illegal drugs is allowed.
10. Students must sleep in their assigned rooms and beds.
11. At 10:00 pm students MUST be in their rooms and must not be disruptive to other students.
12. Minor violations will receive an oral warning. Serious or repeated violations may result in dismissal from the program and, for students under 18 years of age, parents/legal guardians will be notified.

## Release Items

### 1. Program Fees & Information

I acknowledge that the program fees and information are correct at the time of publication.

### 2. Insurance

The program fee includes travel accident insurance for the duration of the camp. Students who wish to remain in China after the program ends are responsible for purchasing additional coverage independently. Cathay Camps strongly recommends that participants also obtain adequate medical and personal liability insurance in their home country prior to travel.

### 3. Compliance

I will comply with Cathay Camps' and any host institution's rules and regulations during the

program period. I agree to observe and obey Chinese laws and regulations, and accept Chinese social morality and customs.

#### **4. Liability Statement**

Cathay Camps puts every camper's safety and wellbeing above all else. Our team maintains rigorous safety protocols throughout the program. The following terms are standard practice for international youth programs and are designed to clarify responsibilities for all parties.

Cathay Camps, its affiliated organizations, administrators, directors, agents, staff and volunteers shall not be held liable for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or expense resulting from circumstances beyond our reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, war, acts of terrorism, strikes, riots, political unrest, epidemic or quarantine, government restrictions, or any act or omission by third-party service providers such as airlines, hotels, restaurants, transport companies or host institutions.

Participants and their guardians acknowledge that outdoor and experiential activities carry an inherent element of risk. Cathay Camps takes all reasonable precautions to minimize these risks, but cannot be held responsible for incidents arising from such inherent risk during program activities.

In situations involving a participant's health or safety, Cathay Camps and its affiliated organizations reserve the right to take whatever actions they deem necessary, and shall not be held liable for decisions made in good faith under such circumstances.

#### **5. Standards of Conduct**

Cathay Camps and the host institution reserve the right to enforce appropriate standards of conduct. Should a participant's behavior be deemed incompatible with the wellbeing of other students or staff, or in violation of the laws of the People's Republic of China, the organizer will work collaboratively with the participant's parent or legal guardian to reach a resolution.

#### **6. Cancellation & Refund Policy**

Due to limited enrollment capacity and pre-committed resources, the following refund policy applies for cancellations due to personal reasons:

- 60+ days before camp start: Full refund
- 30–59 days before camp start: 75% refund
- 15–29 days before camp start: 50% refund
- Less than 15 days before camp start / no notice given: No refund
- After camp begins: No refund in principle. In the case of illness during the program, refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

If the program is cancelled by Cathay Camps due to insufficient enrollment or force majeure, a full refund will be issued.

#### **7. Visas and Travel Documents**

It is the participant's responsibility to obtain the necessary travel documents for entry into China. Cathay Camps recommends checking China's current visa-free policy, which permits nationals of 50+ countries to enter China visa-free for up to 30 days, including for study tours and summer camps. For nationalities not covered by the visa-free policy, participants are responsible for obtaining the appropriate visa independently. Cathay Camps can provide an official invitation letter to assist with the visa application process. Failure to secure the necessary entry

documents does not constitute grounds for a refund.

### **8. Program Price Includes:**

- Enrollment fee
- Course fees including classroom instruction, textbooks and study materials
- Activity fees as per the program schedule
- Certificate issued by Cathay Camps
- 24/7 bilingual counselors and supervisors
- Four-star hotel accommodation

- Transportation fees relating to the program (including train fare for field trips)

### **Program Price Does Not Include:**

- International flights to/from China and related expenses (delays, cancellations, overweight luggage)
- Students' personal expenses (shopping, compensation for damage to hotel or public facilities)
- Phone/data charges
- Medical expenses exceeding insurance coverage
- Chinese visa application fees (where applicable)
- Travel insurance beyond the camp period

# Cathay Camps 参营条款与条件

2026 年文化沉浸中文夏令营

## 学生行为守则

凡有意参加 Cathay Camps 项目的学生，须同意遵守以下行为守则，方可完成报名。

1. 学生须按时出席所有课程，并按时完成作业。
2. 学生须尊重老师，服从授权人员的指示，爱护学习材料，课后保持教室整洁，并对自身行为负责。
3. 学生须尊重同伴及项目相关人员，不得骚扰、威胁、恐吓、伤害或侮辱任何人。
4. 学生不得参与任何斗殴，不得实施任何违反中国法律或本国法律的暴力或违法行为。
5. 学生须妥善保管个人财物，不得损坏学校财产或他人财物。
6. 学生须诚实守信，不得说谎或偷窃，任何时候均须使用文明语言和礼貌举止。
7. 18 岁以下学生不得单独离开营地。
8. 家长/访客带学生离开营地前，须在离营登记表上签字。
9. 严禁吸烟、饮酒或使用违禁药物。
10. 学生须在指定房间和床位就寝。
11. 晚上 10 点，学生须返回各自房间，不得打扰其他学生休息。
12. 轻微违规将给予口头警告。严重或多次违规可能导致被取消参营资格，18 岁以下学生的家长/法定监护人将同时收到通知。

## 免责条款

### 1. 项目费用及信息

本人确认，项目费用及相关信息在发布时准确无误。

### 2. 保险

项目费用已包含营期内的旅行意外保险。如学生在营期结束后仍留在中国，须自行购买额外保险。Cathay Camps 强烈建议参营者在出发前于本国自行购买足额的医疗保险及个人责任险。

### 3. 遵规承诺

本人将在营期内遵守 Cathay Camps 及所有接待机构的规章制度，遵守中国法律法规，尊重中国社会公德和风俗习惯。

### 4. 责任声明

每一位营员的安全与健康是 Cathay Camps 的首要考量。我们的团队在整个营期内严格执行安全管理规程。以下条款为国际青少年项目的通行惯例，旨在明确各方责任，保障参营者与主办方的共同权益。

对于因超出合理控制范围的情况所导致的任何人身伤害、损失、损害、事故、延误或费用，

Cathay Camps 及其附属机构、管理人员、工作人员及志愿者不承担责任，包括但不限于天灾、战争、恐怖袭击、罢工、暴乱、政治动荡、疫情或隔离、政府限制，以及航空公司、酒店、餐厅、交通公司或接待机构等第三方服务提供商的行为或疏失。

参营者及其监护人理解，户外及体验式活动存在一定的固有风险。Cathay Camps 将采取一切合理措施将风险降至最低，但对于因此类固有风险在活动中引发的意外，不承担相应责任。

在涉及参营者人身安全的情况下，Cathay Camps 及其附属机构保留采取其认为必要措施的权利，并对基于善意作出的决定不承担法律责任。

## 5. 行为标准

Cathay Camps 及接待机构保留执行相应行为标准的权利，如参营者行为被认定与其他学生、工作人员的健康、和谐与福祉相悖，或违反中华人民共和国法律，主办方将与家长/法定监护人协商共同处理。。

## 6. 取消及退款政策

由于参营名额有限，且相关资源须提前锁定，因个人原因取消行程的退款政策如下：

- 开营前 60 天及以上通知：全额退款
- 开营前 30 至 59 天通知：退还已付费用的 75%
- 开营前 15 至 29 天通知：退还已付费用的 50%
- 开营前不足 15 天通知或未提前通知：不予退款
- 开营后因个人原因离团：原则上不予退款。如在营期间因病离营，退款申请将依据本政策按实际情况处理。

如因招生人数不足或不可抗力因素导致活动取消，主办方将予以全额退款。

## 7. 签证及旅行证件

参营者须自行负责办理入境中国所需的旅行证件。Cathay Camps 建议参营者查阅中国现行免签政策——目前已有 50 余个国家的公民可免签入境中国，停留期最长 30 天，适用目的包括游学及夏令营。不在免签范围内的国籍，参营者须自行申请相应签证，Cathay Camps 可提供官方邀请函，协助参营者办理签证申请。未能获得所需入境证件，不构成申请退款的理由。
